City of Wimberley to Offer Remote Services as Public Buildings and Facilities Will Disallow Walk-In Traffic Beginning March 24, 2020

In order to help prevent the spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), and per the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidelines, the City of Wimberley (City) is closing public-facing counters and public facilities to entry from the public beginning Tuesday, March 24, 2020.

“Because of the current escalation level of the COVID-19 pandemic, the City of Wimberley has enacted the closing of public departments, lobbies and counters,” said City Administrator, Shawn Cox. “Such decisions are not made lightly. We use the best information from regional partners and trusted health organizations to protect the public and our employees from the spread of this virus.”

New City Closures:

- Beginning Tuesday, March 24th, all City buildings and facilities will be closed to walk-in traffic, with most services still available via phone (512) 847-0025 and online at www.cityofwimberley.com. Closure of City buildings and facilities will be in place until further notice.
